

Code of Ethics

Members should be concerned for the quality of their professional service, should give students the instruction, attention, and the full amount of time agreed upon, and should help each student to develop her or his potential as a singer.

It is unethical for a Member to:

Make any false claims regarding themselves or their students;

Divulge personal or domestic information obtained from a student in the course of instruction;

Try to attract students away from other teachers by any means;

Give lessons to any student while knowing she or he is a regular student of another teacher, without the approval of that other teacher;

Engage in any form of harassment of any student;

Speak in derogatory terms of any other teacher or criticize the work or conduct of any other teacher in the presence of students, or in public.
