Post-conference private lessons with **Jeanie LoVetri**

Saturday 18 and Sunday 19 April 2020, the two days directly following the NEWZATS Conference, both Jeannie LoVetri and Christine Douglas are offering private lessons to singers and voice teachers at Queen Margaret College. Jeanie will give six individual or trio lessons per day. While these are separate from the conference, applications and payments will be administered by NEWZATS and NEWZATS members and conference delegates will be considered first. Due to anticipated high demand, there will be a reserve list in the event of a cancellation.

Jeanie's fees are: 40-minute individual lessons - \$150 | 60-minute trio lessons - \$70/person

Application Process:

- Read and complete the application requirements below
- Apply online at www.newzats.org.nz/private-lessons by 9 February
- NEWZATS Council discuss all applications
- Successful applicants notified and sent an invoice at latest by 29 February
- Lesson payment to be made by 15 March

Application Requirements:

- Name, age, voice-type, contact details
- A short summary of your experience to-date as a singer or teacher
- A short summary of your future goals and plans as a singer or teacher
- A short summary of what you hope to gain from the lesson

Lesson Conditions:

- Conference delegates will be considered first. (Lesson-applicants are encouraged to attend one or all three days, with very good rates for school and university full-time students.)
- Students will be responsible for their own travel and accommodation
- Students are encouraged to record their lessons, but may not share these online
- Students may have an observer (a teacher or family member) free of charge
- Students may have extra observers at \$20 each
- Cancellations before 15 April will not be charged
- Cancellations on or after 15 April will be charged at the full rate unless caused by an emergency

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Notes from Jeanie:

- Lessons are primarily technical/functional, not repertoire based, therefore an accompanist is not necessary
- Students are however welcome to bring a piece of music
 - Students should bring a backing track (ensure you have the technology in order to play it)
 - Or you are welcome to bring your own accompanist.
